TRANSPORTATION PLAN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING VOLUME 1, ARTICLE 10:
TRANSPORTATION, CHAPTER 4: TRANSPORTATION
PLAN OF THE DRIPPING SPRINGS CODE OF
ORDINANCES; ADOPTING A TRANSPORTATION PLAN.

- WHEREAS**, the City of Dripping Springs seeks to increase mobility between existing neighborhoods; and
- WHEREAS**, the City seeks to relieve traffic at the intersection of U.S. 290 and RR12 by providing other mobility points in and around existing and potential development; and
- WHEREAS**, the City desires to increase opportunities for pedestrian, bicycle, and other means of transportation; and
- WHEREAS**, the routes designated in the Transportation Plan are conceptual only, and are not intended to represent current city plans to actually construct roadways in those precise locations
- WHEREAS**, the City has given numerous opportunities for public input through public presentations at the Lions Club, Dripping Springs Women’s Club, Chamber of Commerce, City Council, and Planning and Zoning Commission, and notices in local newspapers; and
- WHEREAS**, the Dripping Springs City Council finds this ordinance to be reasonable and prudent, and necessary for the efficient planning of transportation in Dripping Springs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Dripping Springs City Council:

1. FINDINGS OF FACT

The foregoing recitals are incorporated into this Ordinance by reference as findings of fact as if expressly set forth herein.

2. ENACTMENT

Volume 1, Article 10: Transportation, Chapter 4: Transportation Plan of the City of Dripping Springs Code of Ordinances is hereby established so to read in accordance with *Exhibit A*, which is attached hereto and incorporated into this Ordinance for all intents and purposes.

3. REPEALER

All ordinances, or parts thereof, that are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and remain controlling as to the matters regulated, herein.

4. SEVERABILITY

Should any of the clauses, sentences, paragraphs, sections or parts of this Ordinance be deemed invalid, unconstitutional, or unenforceable by a court of law or administrative agency with jurisdiction over the matter, such action shall not be construed to affect any other valid portion of this Ordinance.

5. CODIFICATION

The City Secretary is hereby directed to record and publish the attached rules, regulations and policies in the City's Code of Ordinances as authorized by Section 52.001 of the Texas Local Government Code.

6. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage and publication.

7. PROPER NOTICE & MEETING

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was passed was open to the public, and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551. Notice was also provided as required by Chapter 52 of the Texas Local Government Code.
