ORDINANCE No. 2019-22

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1.02.045: CITY COUNCIL BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS; MAYORAL APPOINTMENTS TO AREAS OF OVERSIGHT; PROVIDING FOR THE FOLLOWING: FINDINGS OF FACT; AMENDMENT; REPEALER; SEVERABILITY; CODIFICATION; EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROPER NOTICE AND MEETING.

WHEREAS, Chapter 22 of the Local Government Code (Aldermanic Form of Government in a Type A General-Law Municipality; Other Municipal Officers) provides that the governing body by ordinance shall provide for the election or appointment of the officers; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dripping Springs desires to amend the positions the Mayor appoints following municipal elections; and

WHEREAS, the City determines it is in the best interest of the City and the residents to update the manner in which these officers are appointed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Dripping Springs, Texas:

1. FINDINGS OF FACT

The foregoing recitals are incorporated into this Ordinance by reference as findings of fact as if expressly set forth herein.

2. AMENDMENT

Section 1.02.045 City council boards and commissions, Code of Ordinances, City of Dripping Springs, Texas, is hereby amended to read in accordance with *Attachment A*, which is attached hereto and incorporated into this Ordinance for all intents and purposes. Language that is struck through is repealed, language that is underlined is added.

3. REPEALER

All ordinances, resolutions, or parts thereof, that are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and remain controlling as to the matters regulated, herein.

4. SEVERABILITY

Should any of the clauses, sentences, paragraphs, sections or parts of this Ordinance be deemed invalid, unconstitutional, or unenforceable by a court of law or administrative agency with jurisdiction over the matter, such action shall not be construed to affect any other valid portion of this Ordinance.

5. CODIFICATION

The City Secretary is hereby directed to record the attached rules, regulations, and policies in the City's Code of Ordinances as authorized by Section 52.001 of the Texas Local Government Code.

6. EFFECTIVE DATE


This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage.
