 Construction Details; interior elevations, and interior finish schedules
 Structural plans must include: foundation plans, roof & framing plans, wall sections & details
 Mechanical, Electrical, & Plumbing plans & schedules
 Plumbing Plans (include riser diagrams)
 Mechanical Plans
 Electrical Plans (include riser diagrams)
 Lighting Package (if applicable) – Reference Lighting Submittal Checklist

*Plat must be approved & recorded, or Site Plan must be approved and release by the Planning/Engineering department before a building permit can be released.

*IF APPLICABLE – this project may be subject to additional professional fees billed at a later date separate from your permit fees. If you have questions if this applies to your project please ask a Building Permit Technician

*Once permit is issued all licensed subcontractors (Mechanical, Electrical, & Plumbing)
MUST apply for their own permit under General Contractor's permit number via MY PERMIT
NOW. Inspection privileges will not be released until subcontractor permits are pulled.

*BELTERRA COMMERCIAL/MULTIFAMILY PROJECTS ONLY – PLANS MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE DISTRICT OPERATOR (INFRAMARK) AND APPROVAL MUST BE GRANTED PRIOR TO THE CITY BUILDING ISSUING THE BUILDING PERMIT.
