III. **RESTRICTIONS**

Section 1324a(f), the business will be required to repay the amount of the public subsidy with interest, at the rate and according to the other terms provided by the pre-award agreement, not later than the 120th day after the City notifies the business (or a branch, division, or department of the applicant business (or a branch, division, or department of the business of the violation. *The applicant's signature below* certifies that the applicant business (or a branch, division, or department of the business) does not and will not knowingly employ an undocumented worker.
